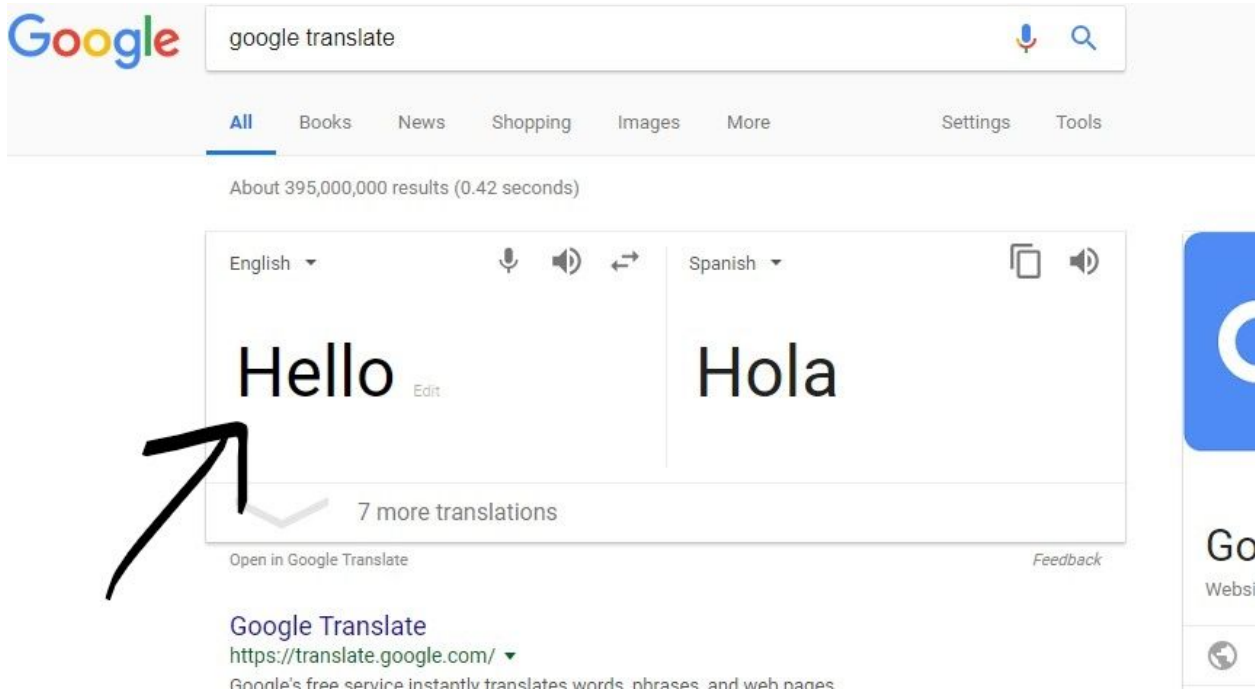


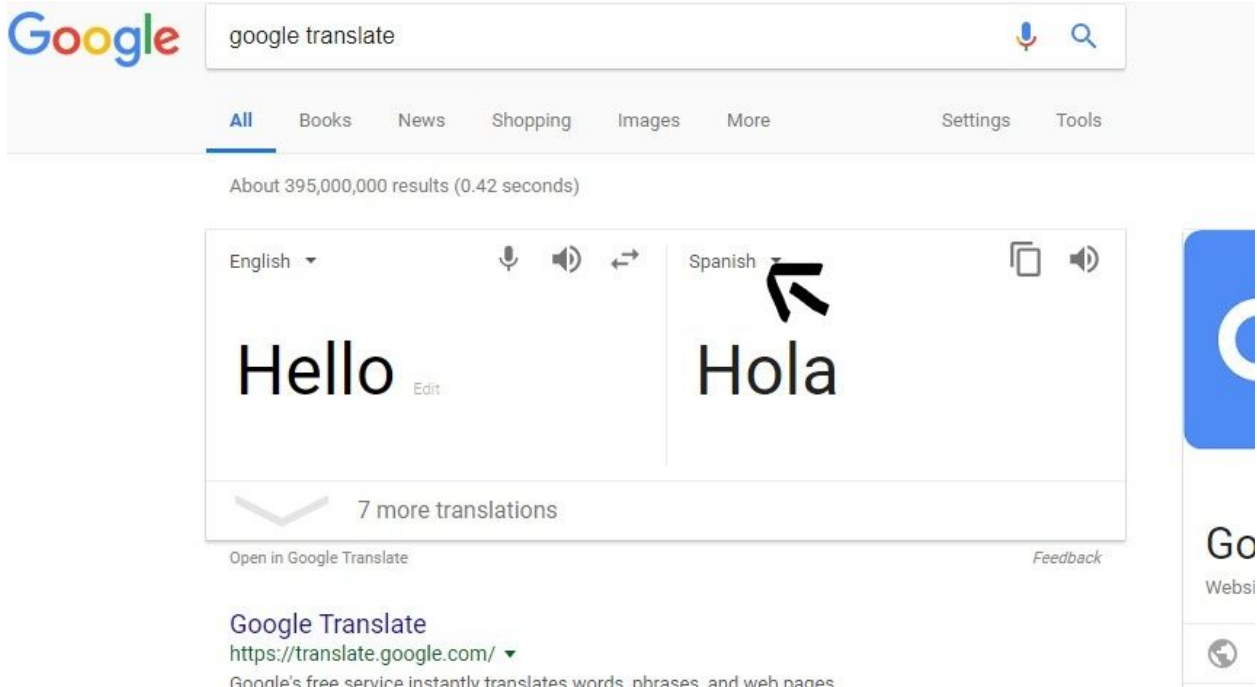
Looking for visitors to find your business?  
Here's how to embed Google Maps onto your webpage.

1. Google search google translate and the box to enter words will appear.

2. Type any word or phrase you want to translate in the box. See example below



3. Hit translate button. It will automatically translate to the language you chose.



4. Click copy to clipboard (See image below)
